Subject: REACH SVHC list (Substance of Very High Concern)

The REACH dispositions regulation of the European Community, in force since June 1, 2007, provide for the registration, evaluation and authorization in the use and marketing of the chemical substances contained in the list of SVHC in the following site: <https://echa.europa.eu/en/candidate-list-table>

The regulation dispositions establish that anyone who produces or imports from non-EU countries a substance as such or contained in a preparation or in an article, has the obligation to register it with the European Agency in charge (ECHA) with the timing and modalities defined by the regulation itself, depending both on the quantity and on the risk factors. For substances classified as hazardous and bioaccumulable, human exposure risk assessments and the estimation of the rich consequences, i.e. the "Chemical Safety Report" (CSR), must also be included; these assessments will then be verified by ECHA, in coordination with the authorities of the member states.

SMARTMETERQ SRL is not a producer of raw materials and/or producer of chemicals, so in this case the registration is not applicable.

SMARTMETERQ SRL, with the current knowledge and on the basis of the information received from its suppliers, for not one of the articles produced and/or marketed the conditions provided for in the REACH regulation are met.

SMARTMETERQ SRL in any case continue to monitor the implementation of the regulation and to ask its suppliers to immediately notify the possible introduction on the market of articles under the conditions of the regulation, in order to take all measures that may become necessary in the future.
